

Simply sit down with them and look and talk about progress. Each time the duotang goes home look for updates.


Parent Teacher Interviews

<u>Reading</u>

<u>Writing</u>

Reading Clubs

You may remember Reading Clubs from the 2014-2015 school year. Well, they are back! Teachers have coordinated to lead reading groups that place students in grades 2-8 into groups according to their reading levels.

Each group works on strategies that will them improve their reading fluency and comprehension.

After a month or so, students will be re-evaluated and possibly moved to different groups.
